



Kindergarten Supply List

Label all of the following items with your child's first and last name:

- 1 Backpack (no wheels) It needs to be able to hold a folder, with lunch box, water bottle, a spare change of clothes, and a light jacket.
- 1 Basic Headphones with a mini plug: no microphone, volume control or earbuds. Please clearly label the child's name on the headphones and place the headphones in a zipper baggie which should also be clearly labeled. They will be kept in storage at the school for use during computer activities.
- 1 change of clothes in a plastic Ziploc bag - *Include undergarments. This will stay in your child's backpack for use in case of emergency. The shirt can be any plain green or blue shirt, bottoms can be any navy blue or khaki (does not need to be an approved uniform, just similar colors).*
- 1 Reusable, Plastic, Clear Water Bottle (With an easy open and close lid)

The following items do not need to be labeled

- 2 Packages of Crayola Colored Pencils
- 2 Packages of Crayola Washable Markers (broad line)
- 2 Sets of 8 Crayola Washable Watercolor Trays

- 1 Plastic 3-prong Blue Folder (for Spanish)
- 2 Green Mead 5-Star Plastic Folder with pockets (no prongs)
- 1 Yellow Mead 5-Star Plastic Folder with pockets (no prongs)
- 1 Box of Hefty Slider Quart Bags (Extra boxes are appreciated)
- 1 Box Gallon Ziploc Bags (Extra boxes are appreciated)
- 1 Box 2.5 Gallon Hefty Jumbo Storage Slider Bags (Extra boxes are appreciated)
