Twelfth Grade Guidance



Checklist for guidance:

- Study hard! Continue earning top grades.
- Retake SAT to improve scores.
- Read for pleasure, however, read challenging material that can help build your vocabulary skills for the SAT & ACT.
- Prepare for early decision/early action or rolling admission November 1-15.
- Ask teachers and counselors for recommendations. Give them a copy of your academic resume.
- Write drafts of entrance essays. Have a teacher proofread before submitting.
- Request transcripts be sent to the colleges to which you are applying.
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on October 1. https://fafsa.ed.gov/
- Register for the Bright Futures Scholarship, if you meet the criteria.

- 1 Physical Education credit HOPE
- 1 online class
- 1 Performing Arts or Practical Arts credit
- 8 Elective credits
- Bible classes do count for elective credits
