

Elementary School- School Supply Lists



Kindergarten

- 1 dozen, red Try-Rex Pencils (Lake Shore Teaching Store on 436 or Amazon.com)
- 4 boxes of Crayola crayons (24 count)
- 1 box of Crayola Classic color markers
- 6 small glue sticks
- 4 pink wedge erasers – *not pencil toppers*
- 1 large box of band aids
- 1 package EXPO white board markers- 8 colors
- 2 packs of baby wipes
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 Magic Erasers (Mr. Clean or other brand is fine)
- 1 plastic pencil box (lid attached- please no metal boxes or bags)
- $\frac{1}{2}$ inch (half-inch) binder with clear, plastic, sleeve on the front - any color
- 1 **clear**, 3-ringed, zipper, pencil pouch – Make sure it fits in the half-inch binder
- 1 set of head phones - (**NO** ear buds)
- 2 activity/coloring books
- 4 wide ruled one subject notebooks
- 1 paper/plastic folder - any decoration or color choice
- 1 paper/plastic folder with NO prongs - 3 holes punched in left side (Needs to fit in 1/2" binder)
- Water bottle with an easy open and close lid that is plastic and clear

First Grade

- 1- 1 inch black or dark blue binder with a vinyl view in the front
- 1 Pencil Pouch for lunch money with a clear front
- 4 large Erasers (Magic Rub brand is excellent)
- 1 large coloring book or (academic) activity book
- 2 Composition Notebooks
- 2 Poly folders with pockets (No Prongs)
- 1 metal magazine/book box
- Crayola Crayons 24 count maximum (It's good to purchase come extra packs while on sale)
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- Headphones (no earbuds)
- Water bottle with an easy open and close lid that is plastic and clear

Second Grade

- 1 King James Version Bible: both Old and New Testament
- 1 water bottle with an easy open and close lid that is plastic and clear
- 1 (any color 1 inch binder with vinyl view in the front, side and back
- 3 poly folders with pockets and prongs
- 2 3 ringed clear, pencil pouch with a clear front for lunch money
- 1 large metal magazine/book box
- 1 packet of notebook paper (wide rule)
- 2 boxes of Kleenex/tissue (please no added lotion)
- 3 pink erasers
- 2 packages of 24 count wood #2 pencil, pre-sharpened
- 3 packages of Crayola Washable Markers
- 10 small glue sticks
- 2 Crayola Crayons 24 Count Maximum
- 2 Composition Notebook

Third Grade

- 1 King James Version Bible: both Old and New Testament
- Standard eraser (no pencil top erasers)
- 2 non-retractable red correction pens
- 2 non-retractable Highlighters
- 12" Ruler with metric measurements
- 5-6 dry erase markers for whiteboards (NOT THE WASHABLE KIND)
- 1 package of **wide-ruled** notebook paper
- 1 pair of children's scissors
- 1 glue stick
- 2 colored folders with pockets (without prongs)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 9 x 12 dry erase board
- Webster's New World Dictionary (paperback)
- Headphones (no earbuds)
- Water bottle with an easy open and close lid that is plastic and clear

Fourth Grade

- 1 King James Version Bible: both Old and New Testament
- 3 Packs Notebook Paper (Wide Rule)
- 1 Clipboard
- 4 Glue Sticks
- 6 Single Subject Spiral Notebooks
- 5 Plastic Folders with pockets (at least 1 red, 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 blue)
- 1 Cloth Pencil Bag
- 1 Scissors
- 2 boxes of tissue
- 24 Pre Sharpened #2 Pencils
- 1 12 pack Crayola Colored Pencils
- 1 8-12 pack Crayola Fine Tip Markers
- 1 package Blue or black pens with caps (not retractable)
- 1 box of Band Aides
- 100 Lined Index Cards
- 2 Pearl Pink Medium Erasers
- 1 package Red Pen with cap (not retractable)
- Headphones (no ear buds)
- Water bottle with an easy open and close lid that is plastic and clear

Fifth Grade

Please label with permanent marker these items with your first and last name:

- 1 King James Version Bible: both Old and New Testament
- 1 standard size backpack (no wheels, no messenger bags)
- 2 plastic pocket folders: red and yellow (for weekly papers and make up work)
- 3 other pocket folders (plastic or paper, solid colors or designs)
- 1 pencil bag (not a box): cloth or soft plastic (large enough to fit everything)
- 1 pair scissors
- 1 basic headphone (no ear buds) for computer class
- 1 pack colored pencils (12 count) for history and science class
- 1 small pack of colored markers for art class only
- Water bottle with an easy open and close lid that is plastic and clear

The following items do not need to be labeled (feel free to label or initial them):

- 3 packages (at least) wide-ruled, loose-leaf notebook paper (only need one pack at a time at school; bring another one from home as needed throughout the year)
- 4 glue sticks (or more)
- 1 package of pencils with erasers (enough to last the year) (not mechanical)
- 1 package of blue or black pens (enough to last the year)
- 4 red pens to grade (or more, or any other color other than blue or black)
- 1 package highlighters
- 4 packages lined 3x5 index cards (only need one pack at a time at school; bring another pack from home as needed throughout the year)
